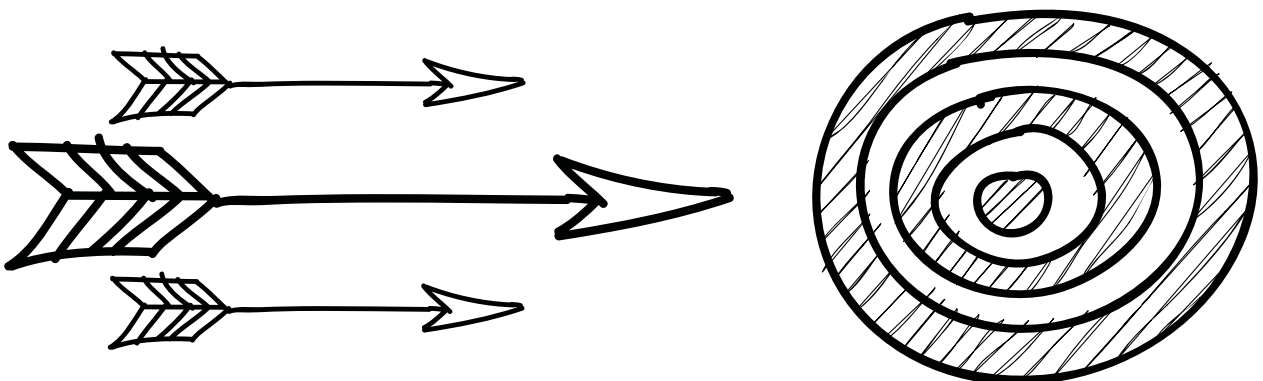

The size of the school right now is a nice size, in the future it looks like there will be more spaces.



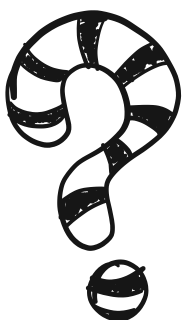
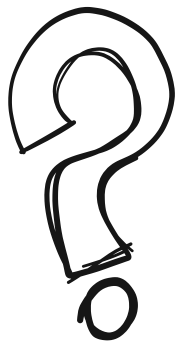
What could change?

People telling us what they think:

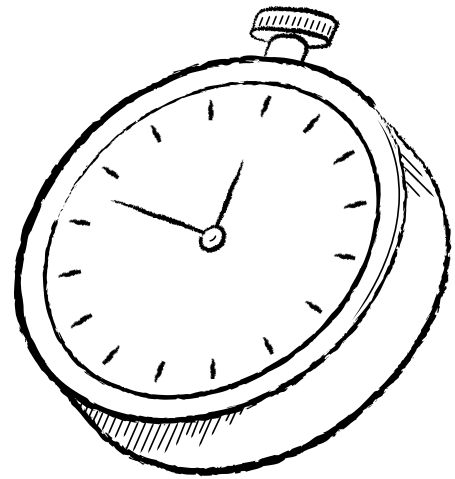
December 2025 to February 2026
