Who are we?

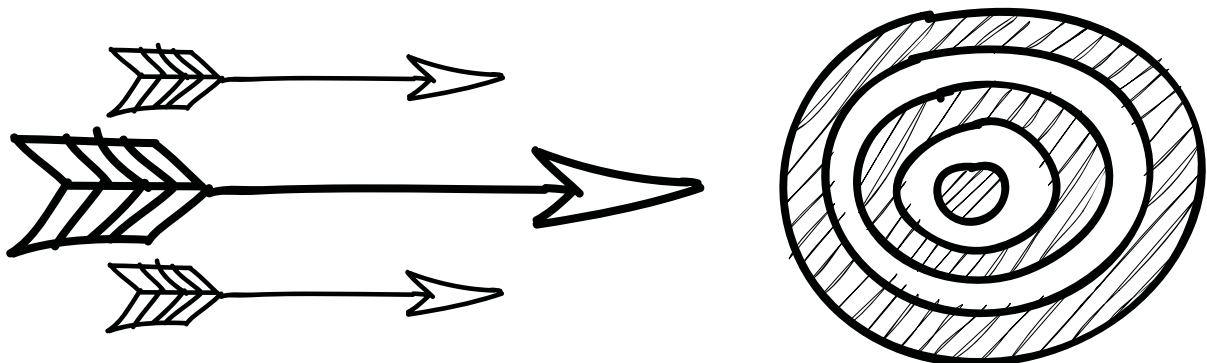
Wrexham County Borough Council are responsible for all schools within our area. We are part of a team that works for the Council to support these schools.

Our aims:

- To give all children the best chance to learn in excellent English speaking, Welsh speaking or Faith schools.
- To have safe and strong buildings.
- To make sure money for children is spent in a fair way.
- To give everybody the opportunity to have their voice heard and listened to in decisions that affect them.

What is happening at the moment?

At the moment there are 3 schools grouped together in the Dee Valley Federation. These are Garth CP, Pentre VC and Froncysyllte CP. At Froncysyllte CP there are less than 10 pupils and this number is going to keep going down.



What is our idea?

We looked at 3 ideas.

1. Do nothing and have a very very small school with less than 5 pupils.
2. Close Froncysyllte CP.
3. Close all 3 schools in the federation and open 1 single school

The option we think could be the better option is to close Froncysyllte CP (Option 2). We cannot do Option 3 because there is nowhere to build a new school nearby.

What could change?

We need to make sure that schools provide the best education for children and young people and we want to make sure that schools are the best they can be.

Sometimes schools need to change to make this happen. We know this can be a worrying time and we want to hear what you have to say.

Some children might have to go to a new school.

Some children may have to travel further to school.

Some children might need a new uniform.

School Changes

Nobody likes major changes to a school.

We understand that this can be a difficult time for the pupils, the people who work in the school and the local community.

Why are we asking you?

The United Nations Convention on the Rights of the Child, or the UNCRC, is a list of rights that all children and young people in Wales and across the world have.

Article 12 makes sure young people have a right to say what they think.

We want to listen to what you have to say. We take everyone's feedback and put it all together to tell the Councillors who make decisions what you said



How long do things take?

People telling us what they think:

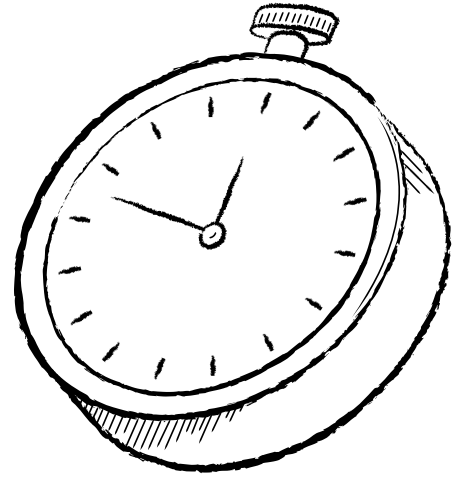
September to November 2025

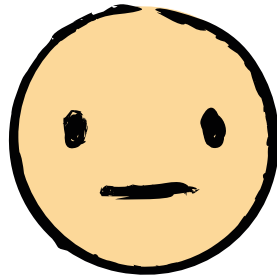

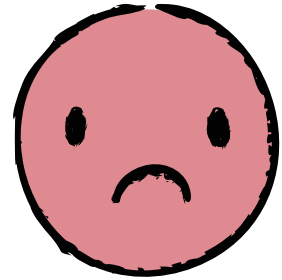

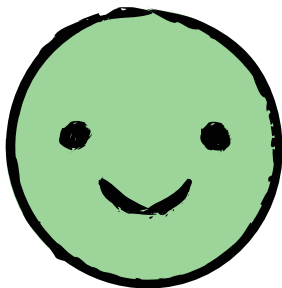
